National Palace (Istana Negara)

The official residence of the King of Malaysia. An iconic landmark featuring magnificent royal architecture and a popular photo stop.



Merdeka Square (Dataran Merdeka)

One of Malaysia's most historic landmarks, where the British flag was lowered and the Malaysian flag was first raised on 31 August 1957, marking the country's independence.



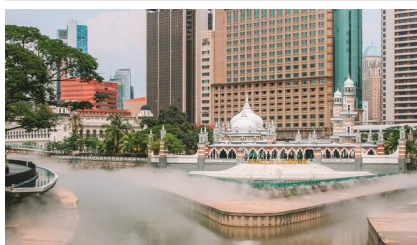
National Mosque (Masjid Negara)

Malaysia's National Mosque, completed between 1963 and 1965. Its unique modern Islamic architecture symbolizes the country's multicultural identity.



Central Market

A renowned cultural heritage site featuring local handicrafts, souvenirs, artwork, and traditional Malaysian delicacies.



Jamek Mosque & River of Life

Visit Kuala Lumpur's oldest mosque, built in 1909, showcasing Mughal, Moorish, and Islamic architectural influences. Nearby, the River of Life redevelopment project has transformed the Klang and Gombak Rivers into one of Kuala Lumpur's most scenic waterfront attractions.



Petronas Twin Towers

Malaysia's most iconic landmark and once the tallest buildings in the world. Located in the heart of Kuala Lumpur (KLCC), they remain one of the city's most recognizable attractions.

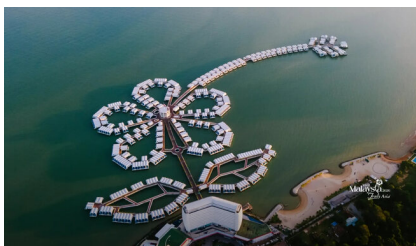
Perdana Putra (Prime Minister's Office) (Photo Stop)
