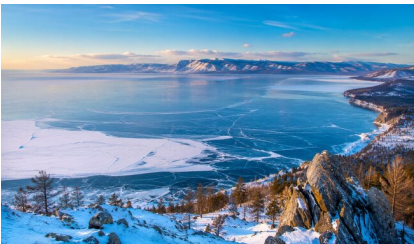

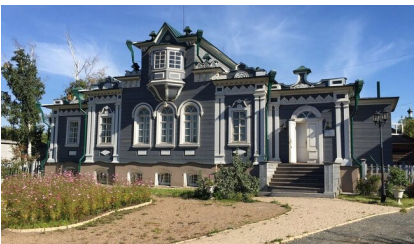
Taltsy Open-Air Museum (Included Ticket)

Cape Khoboy & Three Brothers Rocks (Exterior View)

Cape Khoboy is a famous cliff viewpoint on Lake Baikal with wide lake views. Three Brothers Rocks nearby are linked with local legends.



Cape Khoboy (Exterior View)

Cape Khoboy is located at the northern tip of Olkhon Island. It is known for its dramatic cliffs that drop into deep blue water. The area is popular for sunrise and sunset photography.

Emerald Blue Ice (Exterior View)

Emerald blue ice is a natural winter phenomenon on Lake Baikal. The ice appears transparent with a deep turquoise color. This effect is created by the purity and depth of the lake water.



Icicle Caves (Exterior View)

Icicle caves form during winter when waves and freezing temperatures shape ice structures. Inside, long icicles hang like natural sculptures. Each year the caves change shape depending on weather conditions.



Cracked Ice (Exterior View)

Cracked ice appears as geometric patterns across the frozen lake surface. These lines are created by temperature changes and ice pressure. The result is a natural abstract artwork covering the lake.

Ice Hovercraft Ride (Included)

Ice hovercraft rides allow smooth travel across frozen Lake Baikal. The vehicle can move over both ice and snow surfaces. It provides a unique way to explore remote winter landscapes.



Drone Shooting (Included)

Drone shooting provides aerial views of Lake Baikal's ice landscapes. It captures patterns, cracks, and textures from above. The footage creates a cinematic travel memory.



Bubble Ice Viewing (Included)

Bubble ice shows frozen gas trapped inside the lake ice layers. These bubbles form round patterns beneath the surface. It is one of Baikal's most unique natural phenomena.



"Kiss of Baikal" (Included)

"Kiss of Baikal" is a playful experience involving touching or tasting the icy lake. It symbolizes courage in extreme cold conditions. Many visitors take photos to remember the moment.



Dragon Tail Rock (Exterior View)

Dragon Tail Rock is a natural formation shaped like a dragon's tail. It has been formed over time by wind and water erosion. The shape creates a mythical atmosphere along the lakeshore.

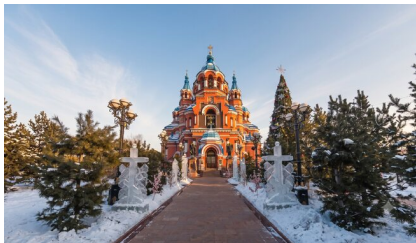

Victory Square is a memorial site dedicated to World War II. It honors soldiers and historical sacrifices. The square is used for remembrance and reflection.



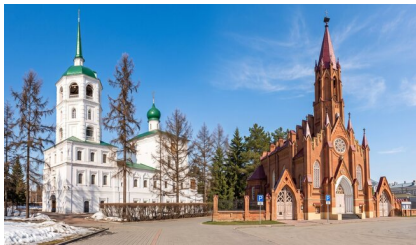
Eternal Flame & Lovers' Bridge (Exterior View)

The Eternal Flame honors fallen soldiers. Lovers' Bridge is associated with romance traditions. Together they represent memory and love.



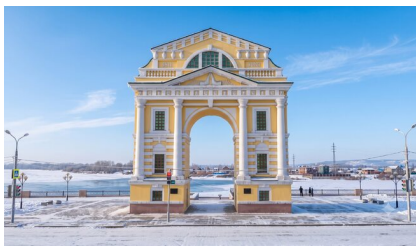
Church of the Epiphany (Exterior View)

The Triumphal Arch is a monument celebrating historical victories. It follows classical European architectural style. It stands as a symbolic city landmark.

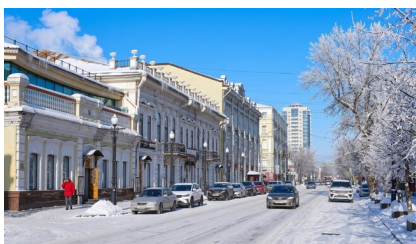

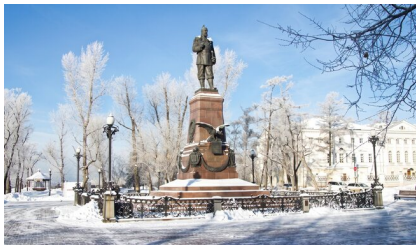
Sukachyov Estate (Include Ticket)
