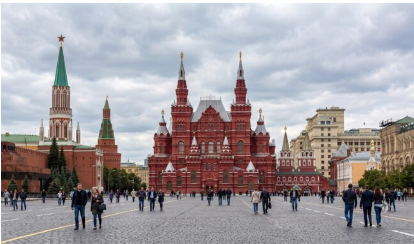

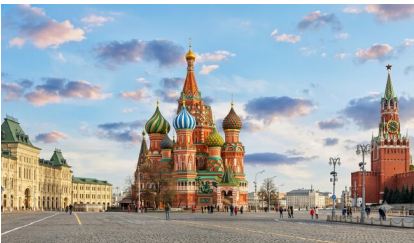

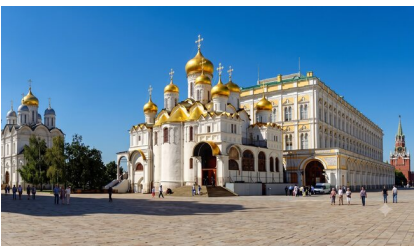
Red Square & Surrounding Sights (Exterior)
ed Square is the historical, cultural, and political heart of Moscow and the ultimate symbol of Russia. Originally a 15th-century marketplace, this massive open plaza is a UNESCO World Heritage site surrounded by architectural marvels.



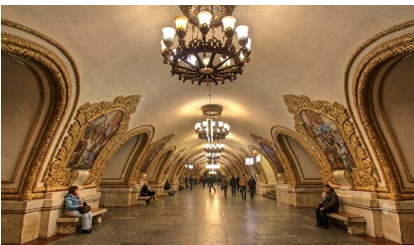
Saint Basil's Cathedral (Exterior)
Perhaps the most recognizable building in Russia, this 16th-century masterpiece is famous for its vibrant, multi-colored onion domes. Commissioned by Ivan the Terrible to commemorate a military victory, its unique architectural design looks straight out of a fairy tale.



GUM Department Store (Entry)
GUM Department Store is a historic and elegant shopping mall in Moscow's Red Square, known for its stunning glass-roofed architecture, luxury boutiques, and variety of restaurants and cafes.



Kremlin (Entry)
The Moscow Kremlin is a historic, fortified complex in the heart of Moscow, overlooking the Moskva River, Red Square, and the Alexander Garden. It features four palaces, four cathedrals, and a wall with 20 towers, and serves as the official.



Moscow Metro (Entry)
These exterior structures serve as a visual prelude to what lies beneath. Passing through these doors and descending the escalators leads commuters into massive, deep-level stations decorated like museums.

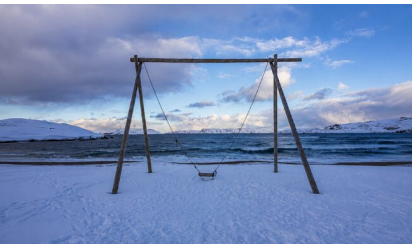
Arctic Throne (Exterior)

The Arctic Throne is a striking art installation located along the coast of Teriberka. It was created in 2021 for the World Cup of Strength Extreme competition. Made from locally sourced driftwood, the throne stands over four metres tall and.



The Abandoned Ship (Exterior)

This abandoned fishing vessel rests quietly on the beach of Teriberka, weathered by years of Arctic winds, snow, and waves. Set against the vast Barents Sea, its solitary form reflects the village's fishing heritage and creates a dramatic northern landscape.



Lonely Swing(Exterior)

The Lonely Swing is a distinctive photography spot located along Teriberka's vast Arctic coastline. Facing the endless Barents Sea and surrounded by open wilderness, sea winds, and dramatic polar scenery, it offers visitors a feeling of freedom and solitude at.



Ship Graveyard (Exterior)

The Ship Graveyard of Teriberka lies near the mouth of the river where it meets the Barents Sea. Scattered along the shore are the weathered remains of abandoned fishing vessels, recalling the village's once-thriving fishing industry and its later decline.

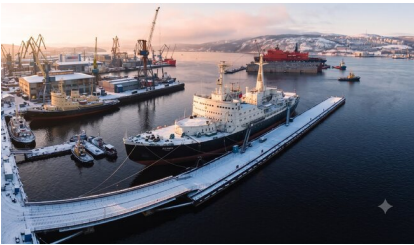

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Murmansk Port & Lenin Nuclear Icebreaker (Entry)

The Murmansk Commercial Seaport and the permanently docked Lenin Nuclear Icebreaker form the industrial and historical heart of Murmansk. As the world's largest city north of the Arctic Circle, Murmansk relies entirely on this ice-free port, and the iconic Lenin.



Arctic Landmark Monument (Exterior)

The Murmansk Arctic Landmark Monument stands at the entrance to the city and serves as a symbolic welcome to this Arctic destination. Rising approximately 20 metres, the monument is crowned by a small sailing ship set within a metal ring,.



Lighthouse Monument (Exterior)

The Lighthouse Memorial in Murmansk was erected in 2002 to commemorate sailors who lost their lives during peacetime. The lighthouse symbolizes hope, homecoming, and the quiet waiting of families on shore, while honouring those who never returned from the sea.



Alyosha Statue (Exterior)

Officially named the Monument to the Defenders of the Soviet Arctic during the Great Patriotic War--is a colossal World War II memorial located in the northern port city of Murmansk, Russia. Standing far above the Arctic Circle, it is one.

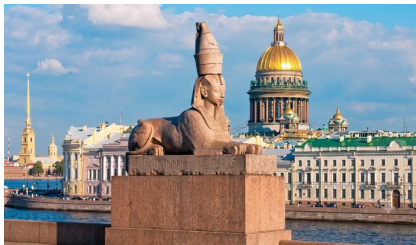
Palace Square (Exterior)

Peter and Paul Fortress (Interior).

Sphinxes (Exterior)

Sphinxes on Universitetskaya Embankment are a pair of ancient Egyptian sphinx statues brought from Luxor in the 19th century, now displayed along the Neva River, symbolizing strength and serving as a unique link between Egypt and Russia's cultural history.



Old Port Light houses of Vasilievsky Island (Exterior)

Located on the Spit of Vasilievsky Island, the Rostral Columns are among Saint Petersburg's most iconic historic landmarks. Built in the early 19th century, these two 32-metre-high columns once served as lighthouses guiding ships into the old port. Their shafts.

Catherine Palace (Entry)

The Catherine Palace is the jewel of Tsarskoye Selo (Pushkin), renowned worldwide for its over-the-top luxury, brilliant blue-and-gold Baroque facade, and its legendary missing treasure. It served as the primary summer residence of the Russian tsars.



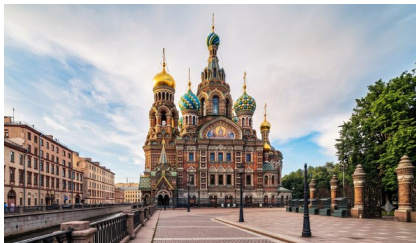
Catherine Park (Entry)

Catherine Park is the sprawling, breathtakingly beautiful imperial park surrounding the famous Catherine Palace. Located in the town of Pushkin (formerly Tsarskoye Selo), about 25 kilometers south of Saint Petersburg, it is a UNESCO World Heritage site and a masterpiece.



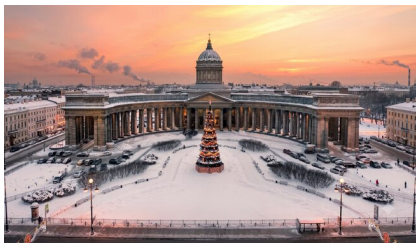
Putin's Birthday Wooden Cottage Restaurant (Included)

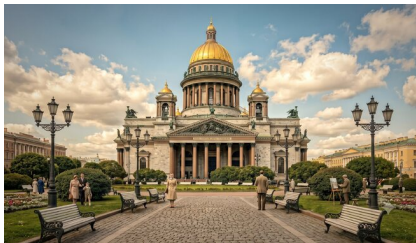

Bronze Horseman (Exterior)
