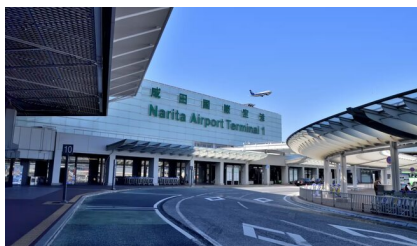

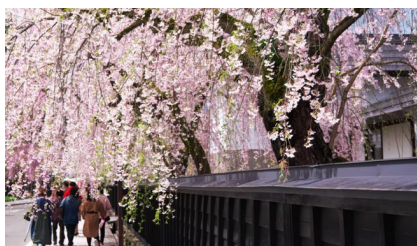
Day 1 *Kuala Lumpur / Tokyo (Narita) JL 724 (2250/0645+1)*



Arrive at Tokyo, Japan (Narita)

Arrive at Narita International Airport in the morning. After immigration clearance, process for your domestic flight to Akita to begin your Tohoku Sakura journey.

Day 2 *(0645am) arrive Tokyo~Haneda / Akita JL 163 (1110/1215)~ Kakunodate ~Nairuku Railway ~.*



Sakura Viewing: Kakunodate • Bukeyashiki

Kakunodate, nicknamed "Small Kyoto" for its size and cultural charm, is in Akita, surrounded by three mountains, including the flower-filled East Mountain. Its scenic terrain made it an ideal site for building a historic and picturesque castle town.



Included Akita Nairiku Jukan Railway, take train from Matsuba to Kakunodate

Enjoy a scenic train ride from Matsuba to Kakunodate, passing through beautiful countryside, mountains, and seasonal landscapes--offering a relaxing and authentic glimpse of rural Japan.



Lake Tazawa

Located in Akita, Lake Tazawa is Japan's deepest caldera lake, reaching 423 meters. A popular vacation destination, it features scenic views and numerous hillside hot spring resorts, offering visitors a blend of natural beauty and relaxing thermal baths.

Day 3 *Kitakami City Park ~ Hiraizumi. Chusonji Temple ~ Gembikei Gorge*



Sakura Viewing: Kitakami City Park

Iwate's Tenshochi Park is a sprawling cultural and forest oasis. Featuring ten thousand 80-year-old cherry trees lining a 2km path, it ranks alongside Hirosaki and Kakunodate as one of Tohoku's "Big Three" sakura viewing spots and a top Japanese destination.



UNESCO: Hiraizumi. Chusonji Temple

A 12th-century Tendai temple in Tohoku, Chusonji symbolizes the Fujiwara clan's historic power. Located on a large mountain and UNESCO-listed in 2011, it remains a resilient masterpiece after 14th-century fires, featuring ancient pagodas accessed via atmospheric stone steps.



Gembikei Gorge

A designated National Scenic Beauty, Gembikei Gorge is famous for its "flying dango." Order by knocking on a wooden board; a basket zip-lines across the river with tea and three flavors: red bean, sesame, and sweet soy sauce syrup.

Mogami River (Included Cruise Ride)

The river cruise lasts about one hour, where you can enjoy scenic views while listening to traditional songs sung by the boatman in multiple languages. Dining on the boat is also available with a reservation.



Ginzan Onsen Street

Steeped in Edo-period silver mining history, Ginzan Onsen features iconic Taisho-era wooden architecture. Famous as a filming location for Oshin, visitors can stroll across the Silver Bridge and enjoy the nostalgic, scenic atmosphere of this historic hot spring town.



Sakura Viewing: Maizuru Park

Located on Mount Maizuru, Yamagata's Kanko Park features two thousand cherry trees surrounding its peak. A favorite local spot for strolling, it offers spectacular seasonal views, from vibrant spring sakura to stunning autumn maple leaves, overlooking the scenic Tendo City.

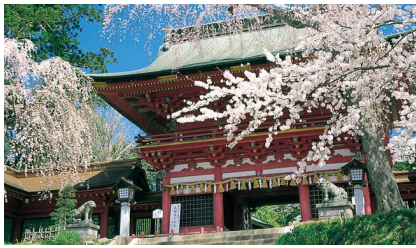
Sakura Viewing: Aoba City Trace

Located in Sendai, Miyagi, Aoba Castle was the 17th-century seat of the Date clan. Now Aoyama Hill Park, the historic ruins offer panoramic views of the city and the Pacific Ocean, serving as a landmark dedicated to Date Masamune's legacy.



Shiogama Fish Market

Located next to Shiogama Port, this market features over 140 stalls offering fresh and processed seafood. Renowned for having one of Japan's largest fresh tuna catches, visitors can enjoy daily hauls of premium maguro and diverse local marine products.



Sakura Viewing: Shiogama Shrine

With over 1,200 years of history, this significant Shinto complex is the protector of fishermen and safe childbirth. It features fifteen Edo-period buildings designated as cultural treasures, standing as a historic spiritual center in the heart of Shiogama City.



Cruise ride on Matsushima -- Japan Top Three Scenery

Praised by poet Matsuo Basho as a rival to China's West Lake, Matsushima Bay features hundreds of pine-clad islands. This iconic Japanese landscape offers breathtaking seasonal views and preserves the historic legacy of the powerful daimyo, Date Masamune.

Day 6 *Miharu Takizakura ~ Aizuwakamatsu Castle ~ Kinutateiwaotsuri Bridge*



Miharu Takizakura

The Miharu Takizakura is an ancient cherry tree in Miharu, Fukushima, in northern Japan. It is a weeping higan cherry (*Prunus subhirtella* var. *pendula* 'Itosakura'. syn. *Prunus spachiana* 'Pendula Rosea'.[1] Benishidare-zakura in Japanese) and is over 1,000 years old.



Aizuwakamatsu Castle

Built in 1384, Tsuruga Castle is a historic landmark in Aizuwakamatsu. Despite its destruction during the 19th-century Boshin War, the castle was rebuilt in 1965. Today, the 280,000m² grounds stand as a resilient symbol of samurai history in Fukushima.



Kinutateiwaotsuri Bridge

Footbridge across a gorge surrounded by lush woodland, with sweeping river & fall foliage views.

Day 7 *Ashikaga Flower Park ~ Hitachi Seaside Park~ Tokyo*



Ashikaga Flower Park

Located in Tochigi, Ashikaga Flower Park spans 9 hectares and is world-famous for its stunning wisteria. Best visited from mid-April to mid-May, this premier attraction offers breathtaking floral displays just a short trip from Tokyo.



Hitachi Seaside Park

In spring, 4.5 million nemophilas (baby blue eyes) paint the 3.5-hectare Miharashi Hills light blue. The nemophilas are stunning under the blue sky against the backdrop of the Pacific Ocean. (Best Viewing Period: Mid of April ~ Beginning of May)
