### Lake Shikotsuko

Lake Shikotsuko is Japan's second deepest lake, formed 40,000 years ago. This crystal-clear caldera lake holds the national record for water quality and never freezes, making it one of the most beautiful lakes in the country.

Takino Suzuran Hillside Park features vibrant red, furry Kokia (broom grass) during autumn. These adorable, spherical plants create a stunning crimson landscape that offers a soothing "healing" visual experience for visitors.

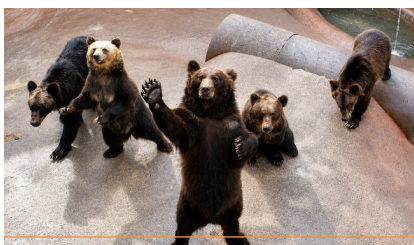
### Lake Toya Fruits Farm (Experience Apple or Grapes Picking)

### Mt. Showa Shinzan (Active Volcano)

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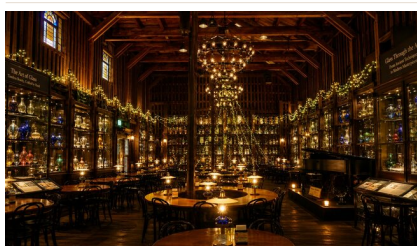
### Biei Hills

### Otaru Canal (Drink Coffee, free Hello Kitty cup)

The Otaru Canal is the symbol of Otaru, once Hokkaido's economic hub. Its historic stone warehouses and gaslights along the water create an impressive and nostalgic cityscape, reflecting the area's prosperous commercial history.



### Glass Factory (Music Box Museum)

The Music Box Museum in Otaru is famous for its collection of over 4,000 beautiful, intricate music boxes. It features the world's largest British-style steam clock, which chimes every 15 minutes, adding a romantic, nostalgic charm to the historic area.



### Sapporo

Shopping Mall / Underground shopping street is the largest entertainment district north of Tokyo. About five thousand restaurants and entertainment facilities are operated in this area

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### Sapporo Nijo Market

### Shiroi Koibito Park & White Chocolate Factory (included entrance fee)

This whimsical chocolate-themed attraction is home to Hokkaido's famous "White Lover" cookies. With entrance fees included, visitors can explore the factory's production process, enjoy the charming European-style architecture, and discover delightful exhibits dedicated to all things chocolate.



### Tanukikoji Shopping Street

Shops sell kimonos, musical instruments and other specialty merchandise. There are also video arcades and movie theaters. Shops with long histories stand next to newly opened Mall. Shop as you stroll the arcade.
