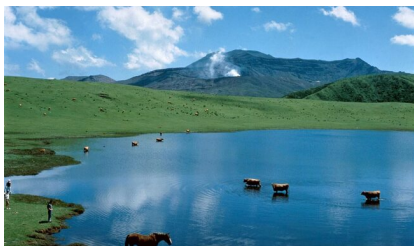
**Beppu. Chinoike Jigoku (Blood Pond Hell)**

As the oldest natural hot spring in Japan, Chinoike Jigoku is famed for its striking, otherworldly appearance. Driven by underground chemical reactions, natural red clay and steam surge from the depths, turning the entire pool into a dramatic, simmering shade.



**Kokonoe Sky Bridge (Famous for maple leaf)**

**Mountain Aso, Kusasenri Grassland**

Kusasenri is a vast grassland located on the northern slope of Mount Aso, one of the largest active volcanoes in Japan. The area features wide green plains, grazing horses, and a small crater lake, creating a dramatic volcanic landscape. Visitors.



**Takachiho Gorge (Famous for maple leaf)**

Takachiho Gorge is a designated national natural monument located in Miyazaki Prefecture. Formed over millennia as the Gokase River eroded volcanic basalt columns created by ancient eruptions of Mount Aso, this breathtaking V-shaped gorge features towering, sheer cliffs of columnar.

**Kagoshima-Sakurajima Volcano Island (Included ferry from Kagoshima Port to Sakurajima)**

Sakurajima is Japan's most active volcano and the symbol of Kagoshima. Located in Kagoshima Bay, this 1117-meter-high landmark smokes constantly with minor daily eruptions, making it a prominent geographic feature with a 50-kilometer circumference.



**Sengan-En (DIY Japanese Matcha green tea & Wagashi Dessert) (Famous for maple leaf & Cherry Blossom)**

The Iso Residence, originally built in 1658 and reconstructed in the 1880s, served as the primary home for the Shimazu family. Today, its rooms remain beautifully preserved, reflecting their authentic appearance and use during the 1890s.



### Ibusuki (Included Sand Spa Experience)

Which is famous for its sand baths, where bathers are buried in naturally heated sand.
