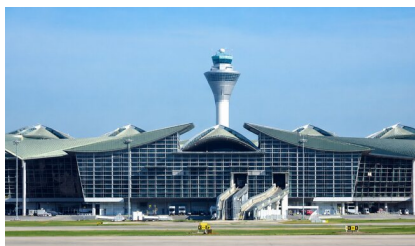

Day 2 *0540AM arrive ~ Himeji Castle ~ Kurashiki ~ Okayama Korakuen*



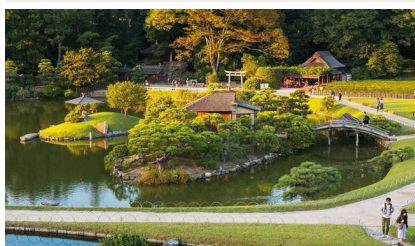
Himeji Castle

Known as "White Heron Castle" for its elegant white appearance, Himeji Castle is a national treasure and World Heritage site. It is one of Japan's twelve original castles, having uniquely survived wars and natural disasters since its construction.



Kurashiki Bikan Historical Quarter

Known for its white-walled residences and willow-lined riverbanks, this preserved historical district blends traditional Japanese architecture with Western influences. Visitors can explore museums of folkcraft and archaeology, experiencing a unique, harmonized cultural landscape.



Okayama Korakuen

Created 300 years ago by a daimyo, Okayama Korakuen Garden is one of Japan's "three great gardens." Symbolizing samurai power, it ranks alongside Kenroku-en and Kairakuen as a quintessential masterpiece of traditional landscape design.

Day 3 *Peace Memorial Museum ~ Itsukushima Shrine*



Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum

The museum displays victims' belongings and photos to convey the atomic bombing's horror. It documents Hiroshima's history before and after the event while addressing the current status of the global nuclear age.



Hiroshima Itsukushima Shrine (Included Ferry)

Located in Hatsukaichi, this UNESCO World Heritage Site features National Treasures. Hiroshima is also world-famous for its mouth-watering fresh oysters, which visitors can sample at their own expense during this stop on the journey.

Proceed to Shikoku from Hiroshima by Great Seto Bridge

Cross the Great Seto Bridge from Hiroshima to Shikoku. This engineering marvel offers breathtaking views of the Seto Inland Sea as you head toward Matsuyama to experience the legendary Dogo Onsen, Japan's oldest hot spring.



Dogo Onsen Street (the oldest spa in Japan)

Japan's oldest hot spring, Dogo Onsen in Matsuyama, boasts a 3,000-year history. Legendary for healing deities and hosting ancient emperors, it remains a popular destination renowned for its high-quality waters and deep cultural traditions.



Botchan Karakuri Clock & soak your feet at roadside natural Hot Spring

Located in Hojoen Square near the station and clock, this mini hot spring lets visitors relax their tired feet. People gather on benches to soak in therapeutic waters flowing from a traditional Meiji Era iron pot.

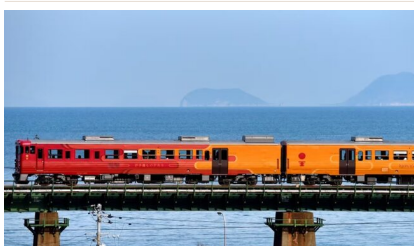
Dogo (Riding Botchan Steam Trains) Matsuyama

Experience the nostalgic Botchan Steam Train, a Meiji-era locomotive part of Matsuyama's iconic tram system. Running between Dogo Onsen and local stations, it offers a historic and charming way to navigate the city.



Matsuyama Castle (Included Lift Chair)

One of Japan's most beautiful original castles, Matsuyama Castle sits atop Katsuyama hill. Accessible via an included lift chair, it offers visitors breathtaking bird's-eye views of Matsuyama city and the scenic Seto Inland Sea.

Day 6 Dogo ~ Imabari Towel Art Center ~ Iya Valley:Kazurabashi Bridge ~ Oboke.



Imabari Towel Art Center

Producing since 1894, Imabari is Japan's leading towel hub, accounting for over 60% of national output. With 4,000 looms and 50 billion yen in annual shipments, it is a world-renowned center for high-quality textile craftsmanship.



Iya Valley: Kazurabashi Bridge (Japan Top Three Old Bridge)

Historically, mountain vine suspension bridges known as kazurabashi were the primary way to transport people and goods across the rivers of the Iya Valley. These ancient structures remain a unique and iconic feature of the region.



Oboke Gorge (Included Boat Ride)

Located near the Iya Valley, these steep gorges on the Yoshino River feature dramatic rocky walls and rapids. Their names mean "big/small dangerous steps," reflecting the perilous nature of navigating their jagged terrain.

Shdo-shima (Kankakei National Park, Include one way cable car)

Kankakei on Shdo-shima is a nationally designated "Place of Scenic Beauty" in Setonaikai National Park. Famous for maple trees and ranked among Japan's top 100 landscapes, the visit includes a one-way cable car ride.



Takamatsu. Ritsurin Park

Built by early Edo Period feudal lords, Ritsurin Park in Takamatsu is one of Japan's premier landscape gardens. Frequently ranked alongside the nation's "three most beautiful gardens," it is a masterpiece of traditional Japanese horticultural design.



Awa-Hall (Enjoy Tokushima Awa-Odori Folk Dance)

Dating back to 1587, this Tokushima folk dance honors ancestors during the Bon season. It originated during celebrations for Tokushima Castle, where sake-inspired unsteady movements evolved into the famous festival dance still enjoyed today.

Naruto Strait Bridge
