## Tsukiji Fish Market

## Zao Snow Monster (Included Cable Car)

As one of Tohoku's largest ski resorts, Zao features rare winter "snow monsters." These unique ice-glazed trees form only under specific weather and vegetation conditions, making them a spectacular and uncommon sight in Japan.



## Ginzan Onsen Street

Ginzan Onsen, a historic silver mining town and "Oshin" filming site, features Taisho-era wooden buildings. Visitors can stroll misty stone roads, cross the Silver Bridge, and enjoy a relaxing foot soak in the hot springs.

### Kakunodate • Bukeyashiki

Travelers enjoy a scenic ride on the Akita Nairiku Jukan Railway from Kakunodate to Matsuba. This included journey showcases Akita's beautiful rural countryside, allowing guests to savor authentic railway bento while taking in the stunning inland landscapes.



### Lake Tazawa

Located in Akita, Lake Tazawa is Japan's deepest caldera lake at 423 meters. This popular vacation destination features stunning scenery and hillside hot spring resorts, offering a serene escape and breathtaking views in northern Japan.

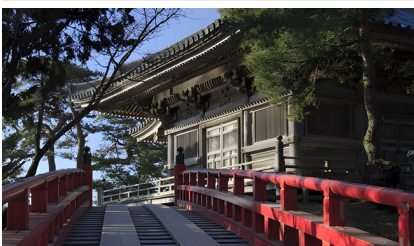

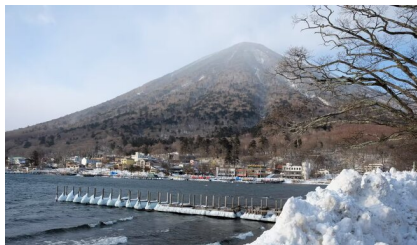


### Mitsui Outlet

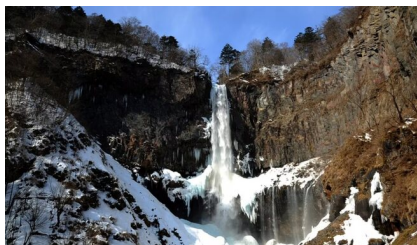

### Lake Chuzenji

Visited on Day 6, Lake Chuzenji is the source of the majestic 100-meter-tall Kegon Waterfall. Its high water pressure creates one of Japan's most famous falls, making it a scenic highlight of the journey through Nikko.



### Kegon Waterfall ( include lift)

The almost 100 meter tall Kegon Waterfall (華嚴の滝, Kegon no taki) is the most famous of Nikko's many beautiful waterfalls. In fact, it is even ranked as one of Japan's three most beautiful falls.



### Nikko Toshogu

Nikko Toshogu is a Shinto shrine located in Nikk, Tochigi Prefecture, Japan. It is part of the "Shrines and Temples of Nikk", a UNESCO World Heritage Site
