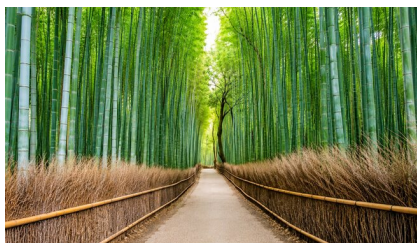
Osaka Castle

Rebuilt in the 1620s by Tokugawa Hidetada, the castle's tower burned down in 1665 after a lightning strike. It was reconstructed in 1931 and underwent a significant restoration in 1997, giving the landmark its current refreshed appearance.



Osaka Water Bus

Ride the Aqua-Liner to enjoy scenic river views of "Osaka Water City." The cruise covers major landmarks, including Osaka Castle, Nakanoshima, Osaka Business Park (OBP), and Osaka Amenity Park (OAP).



Arashiyama Togetsukyo Bridge + Sagano Bamboo Forest

Enjoy recreation at the riverside park during cherry blossoms or autumn foliage. Highlights include walking the Sagano Bamboo Forest Trail to Nomiya Shrine, which features Japan's oldest wooden black torii gate.

Kiyomizudera Temple (World Heritage)

Famous for its 13-meter wooden stage built without nails, this temple offers stunning Kyoto views. Visitors enjoy cherry blossoms in spring and maple leaves in autumn from the observatory. The main hall houses a thousand Kannon.



Golden Pavilion (Kinkakuji) (World Heritage)

Covered in gold leaf, this Zen temple originally stored sacred remains. Despite multiple fires, including a 1950 arson by a monk, the present structure was rebuilt in 1955 and remains a world-renowned landmark.

Kanazawa Kenrokuen

One of Japan's top three landscape gardens, this former Kanazawa Castle outer garden was developed by the Maeda family over two centuries. Opened in 1871, it features stunning ponds, waterfalls, bridges, and traditional teahouses.



Shirakawa Gassho Village

A UNESCO World Heritage site famous for centuries-old gassho-zukuri farmhouses. Built without nails to withstand heavy winter snow, these unique structures feature large attic spaces traditionally used for cultivating silkworms.



Sakurayama hachiman shrine & Takayama Yatai Kaikan

The Float Hall in Sakurayama Hachiman houses 11 fall Takayama festival floats. Four are displayed at a time and rotated thrice yearly. Tours are led by shrine maidens, showcasing the festival's rich traditions.

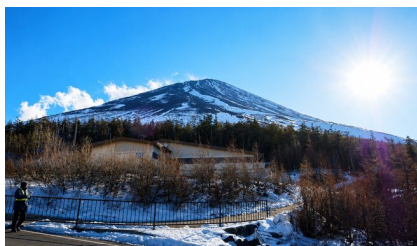
Takayama Old Street: San-machi

San-machi is Takayama's iconic sightseeing district and former merchant center. Highlights include Kami-Sanmachi and the 300-year-old Takayama-Jinya government office, situated along historic lanes linking the castle and temples.



Oshino Hakkai

Oshino Hakkai features eight pristine springs formed by Mount Fuji's volcanic activity. These sweet-water springs are well-preserved by local protection and are officially ranked among Japan's top one hundred remarkable waters.



Mount Fuji (If weather condition is good, will visit to 5th Station)

At 3,776 meters, Mount Fuji is Japan's highest peak. This sacred mountain is highly popular among artists and the general public, serving as a revered and iconic symbol of the nation.

The Imperial Palace Gardens

Kkyo Higashi Gyoen, part of the inner palace, is open to the public on the site of Edo Castle's former defenses. While main buildings are gone, historical moats, walls, gates, and guardhouses remain well-preserved.



Asakusa

Asakusa preserves the traditional "Shitamachi" atmosphere of old Tokyo. Its centerpiece is the 7th-century Senso-ji Temple, reached via Nakamise Shopping Street, where visitors can enjoy local snacks and find unique souvenirs.



Ginza

Ginza is Tokyo's premier upmarket district for luxury shopping, dining, and entertainment. Renowned for its prestigious boutiques and galleries, it features Japan's most expensive real estate, with land values exceeding ten million yen per square meter.



Shinjuku Kabukicho

Japan's largest red light district features countless restaurants, bars, nightclubs, pachinko parlors, love hotels and a wide variety of red light establishments for both sexes and sexual orientations.
