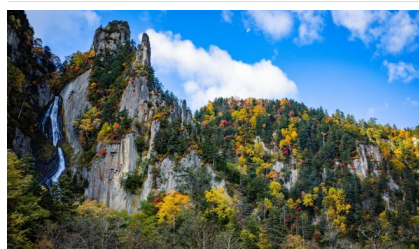
Otokoyama Brewery: Tasting Sakae (Japanese Rice Wine)

Visit the Otokoyama Brewery on Day 2 of your Hokkaido journey to experience a tasting of Sakae, a traditional Japanese Rice Wine. This stop offers a unique opportunity to sample local craftsmanship and authentic flavors during your tour.



Himawari no Sato (Sunflower Season: mid July ~ mid AUG)

Discover Himawari no Sato in Hokuryu, Japan's largest and most beautiful sunflower garden. This majestic destination offers a peaceful escape into nature's silence. Experience these eye-catching landscapes during the peak season from mid-July to mid-August.



Sounkyo Gorge, Ginga Waterfall & Ryusei Waterfall

Explore the "Wife and Husband" falls at Sounkyo Gorge. Ginga Waterfall features graceful silvery rivulets, while Ryusei Waterfall offers a powerful jet. Both are ranked among Japan's top 100 waterfalls, cascading beautifully from the cliffs of Mt. Daisetsu.

Fruit picking: Cherry or Plum

Toya National Park

Toya National Park has distinctive natural scenery, including a caldera lake which is one of the most well known in Japan and Toyako.



Mt. Showa Shinzan

Mt. Showa Shinzan is an interesting landform that was raised from a farmland after two years of volcanic activities.



Bear Park

Visit Bear Park on Day 4 as part of your Toya National Park adventure. This stop allows you to witness these majestic animals up close, adding a unique wildlife experience to your scenic Hokkaido journey.



Mount Yotei (The highest mount in Hokkaido) Meisui park

Mount Yotei, an inactive stratovolcano in Shikotsu-Toya National Park, is nicknamed "Ezo Fuji" for its resemblance to Mount Fuji. This scenic destination also features Meisui Park, which is celebrated for its exceptionally clean and clear spring water.

Otaru Canal (Drink Coffee, free Hello Kitty cup)

White Chocolate Factory

Susukino - HanakojiRamen Yokocho

Susukino - HanakojiRamen Yokocho is the largest entertainment district north of Tokyo. About five thousand restaurants and entertainment facilities are operated in this area.

Sapporo Fish Market - Nijo Market

Former Hokkaid Government Office Building

Beer Factory
