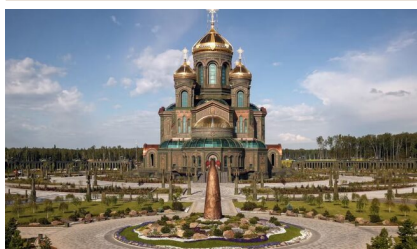

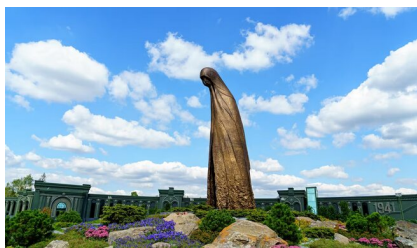
### **Patriot Park (Include Entrance)**

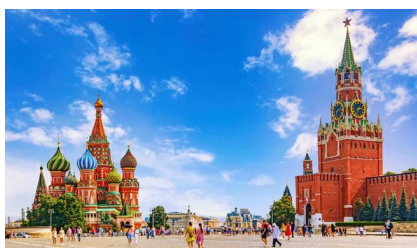


### **Monument to the Victorious Mother**

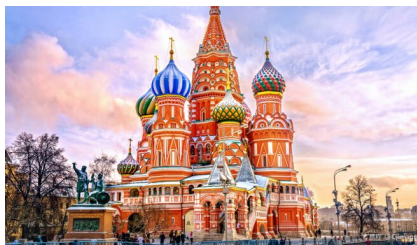

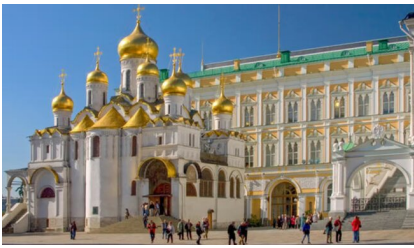
### **Vasily Cathedral**

### The Sphinx

### The ancient port lighthouse on Vasiliev Island

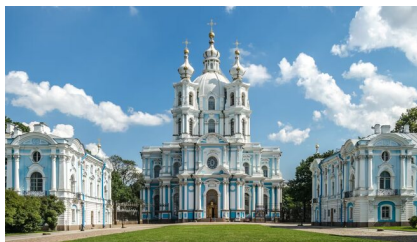

**Isakiev Church**

Saint Isaac's Cathedral is a monumental Orthodox cathedral in Saint Petersburg known for its massive golden dome, richly decorated interior, and panoramic colonnade views over the city.



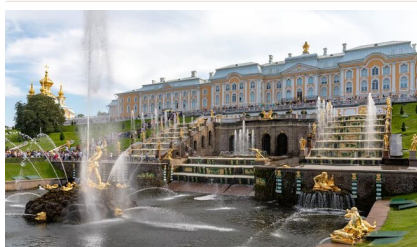
**Twelve-Party Square**
