Day 1 Kuala Lumpur -> Milan (Meal on Board) Reference Flights vary by departure.

Day 2 Milan -> Fox Town (62KM, 1H) -> Lugano (20KM, 30M) -> Interlaken.



Fox Town Factory Stores Outlet Mall

Interlaken -> Lauterbrunnen (by Coach)

Staubbach Falls & Town: One of Europe's highest free-falling waterfalls, plunging nearly 300 metres from a rocky cliff above the Lauterbrunnen valley. Lauterbrunnen Valley is one of the most popular destinations in Switzerland, boasting glacial waterfalls, hiking trails, dramatic cliffs.



Lauterbrunnen -> Jungfraujoeh

At 4,158 metres, Jungfraujoeh is one of the main summits of the Bernese Alps and the top of Europe, offering a spectacular panorama over the Alps.



Alpine Sensation

A multimedia exhibition tunnel celebrating the history of Alpine tourism and the construction of the Jungfrau Railway.



Sphinx Observation Terrace and Plateau

The observation deck at 3,571m offering breathtaking 360-degree views of surrounding peaks and the Aletsch Glacier, Europe's longest glacier.



Ice Palace

Carved within the Aletsch Glacier and the highest-altitude ice palace in the world.



Jungfrauoch -> Grindelwald Terminal

4,158 metres is one of the main summits of the Bernese Alps, the top of Europe and the unique vantage point in the heart of Alps. Enjoy a spectacular panorama view over the Alps.



Grindelwald -> Interlaken

Grindelwald is well known as the most beautiful fairytale town in Switzerland, a famous mountain village embedded in a unique Alpine landscape at the foot of the Eiger's north face.

Day 4 *Interlaken -> Glacier 3000 (87KM, 1H30M) -> Leysin (19KM, 25M)*



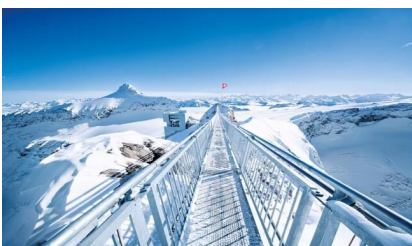
Village of Les Diablerets (Cable Car Station)

A charming Alpine village in the Vaud Alps, the gateway to Glacier 3000.



Glacier 3000

A snowy wonderland for outdoor and adventure enthusiasts where snow can be seen all year round. The cable car ascends to the 9,842-foot (3,000-metre) mountaintop.



Peak Walk by Tissot

The world's only suspension bridge connecting two mountain peaks. The 107-metre long, 80-centimetre wide bridge offers a stunning 24-peak view including the Eiger, Mont Blanc, Jungfrau and Matterhorn (subject to weather conditions).



Ice Express Chairlift

Ride to the glacier for a thrilling alpine experience.



Fun Park (Sledging Fun)

Enjoy sled rides on the slopes of the Glacier Fun Park.



Glacier Walk

A marked glacier trail for an unforgettable walk on ice.

Day 5 *Leysin -> Chateau d'Oex (by Golden Pass Panoramic Train) -> Montreux (1H).*



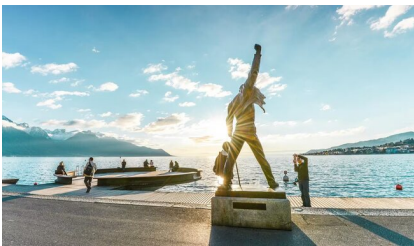
Golden Pass Panoramic Train

An extraordinary journey with panoramic views of breathtaking Swiss scenery, traversing through Chateau d'Oex to Montreux.



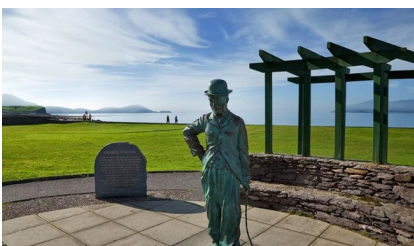
Chillon Castle

An island castle located on Lake Geneva, south of Vevey in the canton of Vaud. Situated at the eastern end of the lake between Montreux and Villeneuve, it now belongs to the State of Vaud and is classified as a.



Freddie Mercury Statue

A monument in Montreux honouring the British singer and lead vocalist of Queen. The emblem of the city is the statue of Freddie Mercury, who famously said: "If you want peace of soul, you should come to Montreux."



Charlie Chaplin Statue

One of the most creative talents of the silent movie era, who spent the last twenty-five years of his life in Vevey. A monument dedicated to him stands on the lakeshore.



The Fork - Alimentarium

An 8-metre high, 1.3-metre wide stainless steel fork on the shore of Lake Geneva in Vevey. Part of the Alimentarium, a Vevey-based museum with a permanent exhibition on food and Nestlé history.



Olympic Park

The home of the International Olympic Committee in Lausanne, featuring gardens and monuments commemorating the modern Olympic movement.



Ouchy Promenade

A picturesque lakeside promenade in Lausanne along Lake Geneva, lined with flower gardens, cafés and views of the French Alps.

Day 6 Geneva/Annemasse -> Genoa (382KM, 4H50M)



Lake Geneva - Jet d'Eau Water Fountain

Literally meaning "water jet," the huge fountain on Lake Geneva in the city of Geneva -- one of the tallest fountains in the world.



Flower Clock

A famous floral clock in Geneva's English Garden, a symbol of Switzerland's watchmaking tradition with a working clock mechanism set among colourful flowers.



Piazza Matteotti

One of the main squares of Genoa.



Palazzo Ducale

The Doge's Palace, a historical building in Genoa.



Cathedral di San Lorenzo

The Cathedral of Saint Lawrence, a Roman Catholic cathedral in the Italian city of Genoa.



Via Giuseppe Garibaldi

A street in the historical centre of Genoa, well known for its ancient palaces.



Teatro Carlo Felice

The main opera house of Genoa, completed in 1828.

The Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II Mall

One of the world's oldest shopping malls. Housed within a four-story double arcade in central Milan, the Galleria is named after Vittorio Emanuele II, the first king of the Kingdom of Italy.
