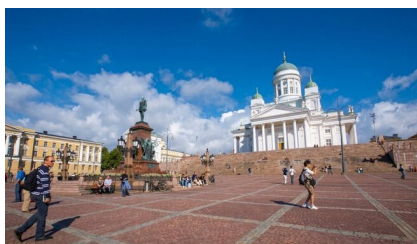

Market Square

Helsinki's iconic open-air marketplace on the South Harbour waterfront, brimming with fresh produce, local handicrafts and the lively spirit of Finnish daily life.



Senate Square

The monumental heart of Helsinki, framed by the grand neoclassical Helsinki Cathedral, the Government Palace and the University of Helsinki -- one of the finest examples of neoclassical urban planning in Northern Europe.



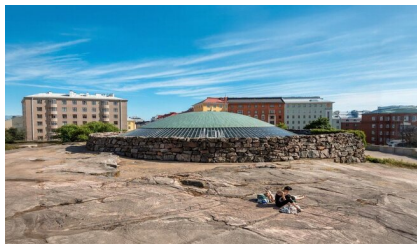
Government Palace

An imposing neoclassical building on Senate Square, serving as the official venue for Finnish government functions and state ceremonies since the 19th century.



Sibelius Monument and Park

Dedicated to Finland's most celebrated composer, Jean Sibelius, this striking abstract monument of over 600 hollow steel pipes stands in a peaceful park in the Töölö district of Helsinki.



Tempeliaukio Rock Church

A remarkable Lutheran church excavated directly into solid bedrock in the Töölö neighbourhood. Designed by architects Timo and Tuomo Suomalainen and opened in 1969, its copper-domed ceiling and natural rock walls create an extraordinary acoustic and visual experience. (Entrance Included).

Aurora Borealis

Aurora Borealis is a beautiful and mysterious natural phenomenon that occurs when solar winds interact with the Earth's magnetic field, causing high-energy electrons and ions to enter the Earth's atmosphere and collide with gas molecules, releasing energy and producing brilliant.



King Crab Safari with Snowmobile Sleigh Ride + Norwegian Set Lunch Seafood

Snow Hotel

Situated 8km outside Kirkenes in the secluded wilds of Northern Norway since 2006. Dreamlike rooms uniquely carved by master ice sculptors from around the world. The hotel is built completely of snow and ice, and each spring melts back into.



Reindeer Farm

Experience Finland's deep-rooted Sámi herding culture with a visit to a traditional reindeer farm, where these iconic Arctic animals have been the lifeblood of Lapland communities for centuries. (Entrance Included)



Reindeer Sleigh Short-Ride Safari

Glide silently through a snow-covered Finnish forest, pulled by a gentle reindeer on a traditional wooden sleigh -- an experience straight out of a fairy tale. (Subject to Weather Conditions)



Aurora Cabin / Glass Igloo / Modern Igloo / Deluxe Glass Igloo / Modern Glass Villa

The igloo has become a feature and symbol of Finland. Sleeping under a glass roof multiplies your chances of seeing the renowned Aurora Borealis. In the warm igloo, you can lie comfortably in bed, look up and capture the aurora.



Husky Dog Farm

Also known as the Polar Husky, this is Lapland's most heartfelt visit. Explore the Huskies Farm to learn about their daily routines and training. Husky sledding is a truly thrilling and memorable experience. (Entrance Included)



Husky Safari Experience

Take the reins of your own dog-powered sled and race through snowy Lapland forests at exhilarating speed, guided by a team of enthusiastic, well-trained huskies. (Subject to Weather Conditions)



Ice Fishing Safari Experience

Rovaniemi in Lapland, Finland, presents a truly Finnish experience -- ice fishing. An activity that can be experienced using a new skill of ice fishing on river ice or on wilderness lake's ice. (Subject to Weather Conditions)

Tankavaara Gold Museum

Santa's Main Post Office

A tourist destination in Santa Claus Village in the Arctic Circle. Visitors can read letters sent to Santa, and arrange to have a letter mailed from Santa before Christmas. This special Arctic Circle postmark is a popular collectable and souvenir.



Arctic Circle

It is almost impossible not to cross the Arctic Circle in Rovaniemi -- it is a must-do activity in Santa Claus Village. (Walking Orientation)



Christmas House
