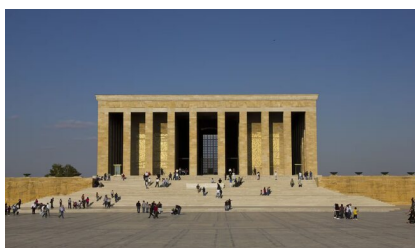

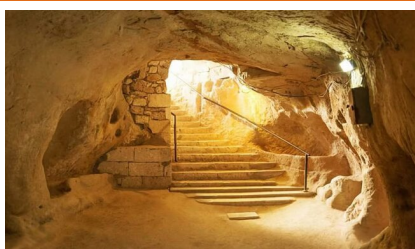


### Salt Lake (Photo Stop)

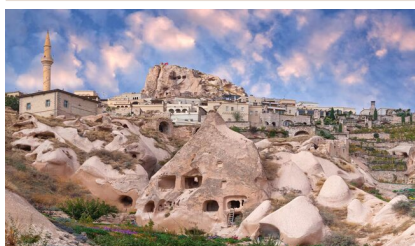
### Underground City (Entrance Included)

Explore a fascinating underground city with a history spanning thousands of years. Discover its tunnels, storage rooms, and living quarters while learning about ancient civilizations.



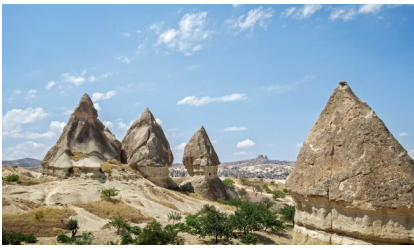
### Uchisar Castle Village (Photo Stop)

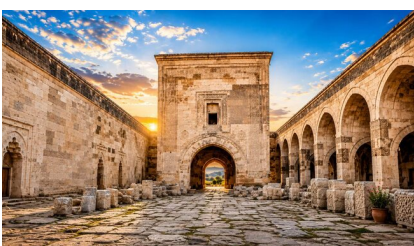
