Day 1 Kuala Lumpur ~ Ipoh



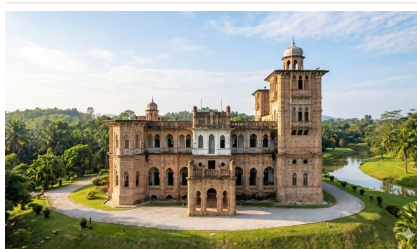
Perak Cave Temple

is one of Malaysia's most iconic limestone cave temples. Discovered in 1926 by a Chinese immigrant couple, the site was painstakingly transformed over decades into a magnificent place of worship. Inside the cool, high-ceilinged cavern sits a majestic 40-foot (12-meter).



Ipoh railway station

The "Taj Mahal of Ipoh", Completed in 1917, the Ipoh Railway Station is a stunning colonial landmark designed by British architect Arthur Benison Hubback. It earned its exotic nickname due to its grand Moorish and Victorian architecture, featuring striking white.



Kellie's Castle

Built in 1915 by Scottish planter William Kellie-Smith as a gift for his family, Kellie's Castle is an unfinished mansion blending Moorish, Indo-Saracenic, and Romanesque architecture. It was designed to feature secret tunnels and Malaya's first elevator. Construction was halted.



Concubine Lane

Established in 1908 following a major fire that rebuilt Ipoh Old Town, Concubine Lane (Lorong Panglima) earned its scandalous name because wealthy Chinese tin tycoons and British officers famously kept their mistresses and second wives in the townhouses here. The.

Penang Mural Street

is one of the most popular attractions in George Town, Malaysia. It is famous for its creative wall murals and steel rod sculptures that are scattered around the old heritage streets. The street art began gaining attention after artist Ernest.



Chow Clan Bridge Water Village

is the largest and most famous water village in George Town, Penang. Built in the late nineteenth century by Chinese immigrants from Fujian Province, this settlement on stilts was created by dock laborers who pooled resources based on their shared.



Kek Lok Si Temple

is the largest Buddhist temple in Malaysia and one of the most popular tourist attractions in the country. Built in 1890, the temple is famous for its beautiful architecture, which combines Chinese, Thai, and Burmese styles. The temple features many.

Cheong Fatt Tze Mansion

Cheong Fatt Tze Mansion, widely known as The Blue Mansion, is a historic 19th-century courtyard home in George Town, Penang, Malaysia. Famous for its indigo-blue facade, the UNESCO-awarded site operates as a boutique hotel, museum, and event space.



Fort Cornwallis

is a bastion fort in George Town, Penang, Malaysia, built by the British East India Company in the late 18th century. Named after the then Lieutenant-General The 2nd Earl Cornwallis, the Governor-General of Bengal at the time of the fort's.



Baba & Nyonya Heritage Museum

also known as the Baba Nyonya Heritage Museum, is a museum in Malacca City, Malacca, Malaysia that showcases the local history of descendants of ethnic Chinese-Malays called Baba-Nyonya or Peranakan in the state.



Penang Hill (Include Ticket)

is a popular hill resort located in Penang, near George Town. It is one of the oldest colonial hill stations in Malaysia and stands about 833 meters above sea level. Visitors usually reach the top using the Penang Hill funicular.
