第 2 天 **(0540 am)** 抵达大阪~ 京都. 伏见稻荷大社~ 高山



京都. 伏见稻荷大社

是在公元 8 世纪, 致力于大米和酒的神由畑家庭。随着农业的作用减弱, 神被纳入, 以确保繁荣商业。如今, 靖国神社是日本最流行的之一, 是头神社约 40,000 稻荷神社分散在全国的长度和广度。



高山. 樱山八幡宫. 屋台会馆 (Takayama Yatai Kaikan) 樱山八幡宫内的屋台会馆, 保存着秋季高山祭巡游时使用的 11 台神轿彩车 (屋台)。这里每年举办三次神轿彩车展示活动 (3 月、7 月、11 月), 每次轮流展出其中的 4 台。

第 3 天 高山~ 白川乡合掌村~ 金泽



高山阵屋

这是江户时代的代官所, 过去曾在日本国内有 60 处以上, 可是现存只有高山一处了。在江户时代进行统治管理的地方。在这之中有官员的府邸以及包括收纳税收的仓库, 总称为阵屋。管理裁判所和纳税的政府部门。由于可以从资源丰富的山林中出产资源 (木材) 和地下资源中获取矿材 (金银铜铅), 所以高山是江户幕府直接管辖的地区, 成为了幕府的经济基础。



高山古街: 上三之町

自古就是庶民的居住买卖之所, 以商人汇聚之街繁盛至今。远在 300 多年以前, 大名及郡代、代官等在此设立馆邸一阵屋。被指定为完好保存了日本重要的传统建筑群的代表性地域, 所用的木材据说是以古有不可采伐之说的桧树杉树等 5 种高级树木, 为掩盖其宅邸的奢华, 以防止官府发现后予以破坏, 只好用柿子汁及烟灰涂抹, 遂成一片灰黑。以酒窖、家庭咖啡为代表的饮食店、工艺品店铺等多数使用古已有之的老式建筑。



白川乡合掌村

在 1995 年列为世界遗产, 白川乡著名的传统合掌农舍, 其中一些更超过 250 年。合掌顾名思义是佛教僧侣双手压在一起祈祷。这建筑风格发展了多代, 其设计是能够承受在冬季下的大雪。屋顶没有使用钉, 大阁楼空间用于培养蚕虫。

金泽. 东茶屋街



金泽兼六园 (赏花季节: 4 月中旬)

称为日本三个最美丽的风景花园之一。有各种池塘, 溪流, 瀑布, 小桥, 茶座, 树木, 石头和鲜花。兼六园的字面意思是“兼顾六原素的公园”, 指的是宽敞, 僻静, 矫揉造作, 古色古乡, 丰富水原和广泛视野, 而据中国景观理论是这六个基本因素, 构成了一个完美的花园。

金泽. 近江町市场



立山黑部阿尔卑斯山脉路线

是穿越日本北方阿尔卑斯的一条壮观的旅游路线，可以很容易地使用各种交通工具来旅行，包括缆车、电车和索道。立山黑部阿尔卑斯山脉路线于 1971 年建成，连接富山县的富山市和长野县的大町镇。立山站和扇沢站之间的路段不对私人车辆开放。该路线 4 月中旬到 11 月开放。

4. 大观峰→黑部平 : 【空中缆车】 (1.7km - 7 分钟 - 海拔 1828m)
5. 黑部平→黑部湖 : 【地下铁道缆车】 (0.8km - 5 分钟 - 海拔 1455m)
6. 黑部湖→黑部水坝 : 【徒步走过水坝上方】 (0.8km - 15 分钟 - 海拔 1470m)
7. 黑部水坝→扇泽 : 【无轨道电车】 (6.1km - 16 分钟 - 海拔 1433m)

第5天 松代城迹公园 赏樱花~善光寺~草津温泉. 汤田旧街



松代城迹公园

松代城是日本长野县长野市松代町松代的城郭。又有海津城之称。形式上像轮郭式平城。日本国内指定史迹。

善光寺

作为长野市门面的「善光寺」，据说这是「不管再远也要去参拜过一次的寺庙」唷！这里有许多具有特色的小商店，就像在逛老街，在这一带许多建筑都保留了过去的容貌。

★【日本三大名汤之一: 草津汤田旧街】自然涌泉量为日本第一，泉质为全国屈指可数的强酸性、拥有优越的杀菌力，更是「日本温泉百选」的十年霸第一名；在日本战国时代，据闻很多受伤的武士前往这里泡汤疗伤，因其疗效而广泛流传；「汤畑」是这里的象征地标，每分钟大约有 4000 公升温泉冒着热气从里面喷涌而出

第 6 天 草津~伊香保:温泉古街·伊香保神社~水泽观音寺~高崎. 箕乡芝樱公园



伊香保温泉古街·伊香保神社-古街，共有 365 个石段，据说攀登上石段，可以增加好运呢！已有 400 年历史的伊香保御关所到伊香保神社之间的约 300 米长的石台阶，在石台阶两侧，旅馆、纪念品店鳞次栉比，途中有 4 处观景处，透过玻璃可看到流入各旅馆的温泉水流。



水泽观音寺

约 1300 年前创建的历史悠久的寺院。是伊香保的标志性景观，有许多游客远道来访，门前的名产水泽乌龙面街很是热闹。水泽乌龙面被称为日本三大乌龙面之一，韧性强且具有透明感。



高崎箕乡芝樱公园-占地 2.9 公顷，约有 26 万株芝樱，每年举行的箕乡芝樱祭，以【织女遗忘的粉红色天衣】为主题，以芝樱丘陵为中心，红、白、粉色的芝樱呈现带子、波浪、漩涡等图案，形成一幅独特的风景。

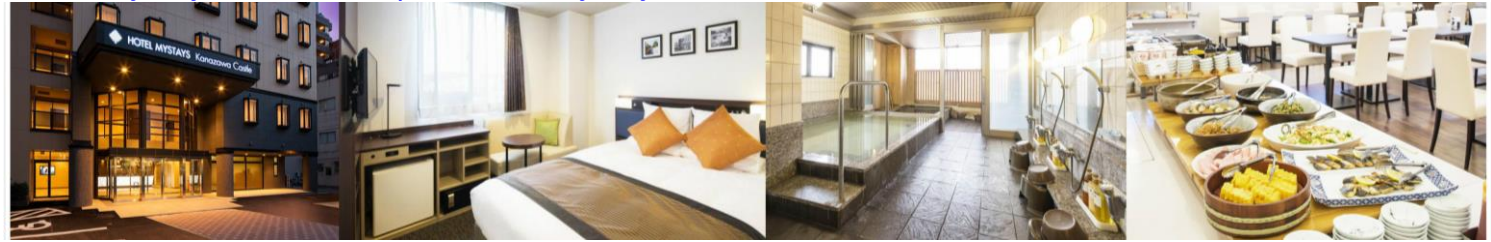

Kyoto . Fushimi Inari Grand Shrine

Was dedicated to the gods of rice and sake by the Hata family in the 8th century. As the role of agriculture diminished, deities were enrolled to ensure prosperity in business. Nowadays, the shrine is one of Japan's most popular and is the head shrine for some 40,000 Inari shrines scattered the length and breadth of the country.



Takayama

Sakurayamahachiman shrine&Takayama Yatai Kaikan

The Float Hall is in Sakurayamahachiman, and houses 11 floats for the fall Takayama festival. They rotate the floats 3 times a year (March, July, and November) putting 4 on display each time. In a revival of the festival parade, a shrine maiden takes visitors on a tour.

Takayama Jinya

Was a local governor's office during the Edo period. Has more than 60 similar buildings in Japan, however Takayama Jinya is the only one left today. Prefectural and district governors used it as an office to govern Hida during the Edo period. The present building complex is called "Jinya" that includes residential space and storehouses for rice paid as tax. Takayama was well known for its abundant forest resource to produce timbers and an underground natural resource of gold, silver, copper and lead. This is one reason why the Shogunate put Takayama under the direct control as an important economic area.

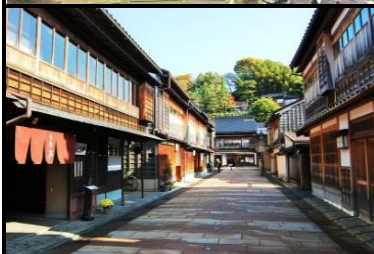


Takayama Old Street : San-machi

San-machi, the old streets, is the iconic district for sightseeing in Takayama. This merchant center was the prosperous heart of the community during the old castle town days. Kami-Sanmachi is especially worth a visit. The old downtown area grew as people gathered along the lanes linking the castle, prominent temples and shrines, and also flourished around the Takayama-Jinya, the old government office that was built over 300 years ago. The Jinya still stands today. History feels alive in these beautiful old streets, which have been selected as an important traditional building preservation area.



Shirakawa Gassho Village-Declared a UNESCO world heritage site in 1995, famous for their traditional gassho-zukuri farmhouses, some of which are more than 250 years old. The architectural style developed over many generations and is designed to withstand the large amounts of heavy snow that falls in the region during winter. The roofs, made without nails, provided a large attic space used for cultivating silkworms. **(Sakura Viewing : Mid of April)**



Higashi Chaya -- A chaya is an exclusive type of restaurant where guests are entertained by geisha who perform song and dance. During the Edo Period, chaya were found in designated entertainment districts, usually just outside the city limits. Kanazawa has three, well preserved chaya districts, Higashi Chayagai , Nishi Chayagai and Kazuemachi.



Kanazawa Kenrokuen (Sakura Viewing : Mid of April)

Classified as one of Japan's "three most beautiful landscape gardens". Many people consider it the best of them all. Constructed by the ruling Maeda family over a period of nearly two centuries, it was not opened to the public until 1871. Kenrokuen features various ponds, streams, waterfalls, bridges, teahouses, trees, stones and flowers.

Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route

Is a unique and spectacular route through the Northern Alpine Mt., which is traversed by various transportation, including cable cars, train, ropeway and bus. The route is particularly famous for the high Snow walls that line some of its roads in spring. This road is only opened from April to November.

6. Kurobe Lake→Kurobe Dam : **【Walking Distance】 (0.8km - 15min - sea level 1470m)**
7. Kurobe Dam→Ogizawa : **【Train】 (6.1km - 16min - sea level 1433m)**

Matsushiro Castle

Matsushiro Castle is a Japanese castle located in former Matsushiro town, now part of the city of Nagano, northern Nagano Prefecture, Japan. At the end of the Edo period, Matsushiro Castle was home to the Sanada clan, daimyō of Matsushiro Domain. The site is a registered National Historic Site by the Japanese government.

Zenko-ji Temple

Is one of the most important temples in Nagano. There are lot of shops along the building selling local souvenirs and small restaurants to eat. **(Sakura Viewing : Mid of April)**



【Kusatsu Onsen (Japan Top 3 Hot Spring)】 visit Yubatake Onsen Old Street. In the middle of the town there is an area called the "Yubatake," where 230,000 barrels of onsen water flow out of the ground every day.

Ikaho Mizusawa-dera

According to temple legend, the temple dates to the Asuka period and was founded by the Kokushi of Kozuke province during the reign of Empress Suiko, who invited a high-ranking prelate from Goguryeo to introduce Buddhism to the region. However, the temple has no records or structures pre-dating the Edo period to help verify its claim.



Ikaho Onsen Street & Ikaho Shrine - The most interesting view in Ikaho Onsen Street will be the 300 metres long and 360 steps stairs which have more than 400 years of history. There are a lot of beautiful scenery with the many of hot spring resort and souvenir shop along the stairs.



Misato Shibazakura Park

Every year from the middle of April, the Shibazakura (moss phlox or moss pink) Park in Misato is open for just one month. Visitors from near and far come here to be surrounded by tens of thousands of brightly hued moss phlox

Ashikaga Flower Park

Ashikaga Flower Park is a park of about 9 hectares (23 acres) that showcases the beauty of mainly wisteria (fuji) as well as many other flowers. It is the most famous attraction in the city of Ashikaga in Tochigi prefecture, about 1 1/2 to 2 hours from Tokyo.

Hitachi Seaside Park

In spring, 4.5 million **nemophilas (baby blue eyes)** paint the 3.5-hectare Miharashi Hills light blue. The nemophilas are stunning under the blue sky against the backdrop of the Pacific Ocean.
